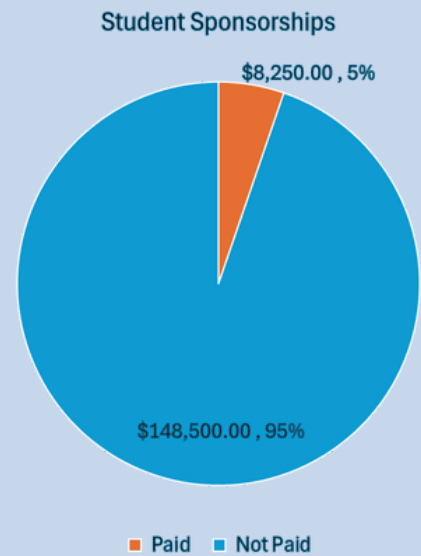

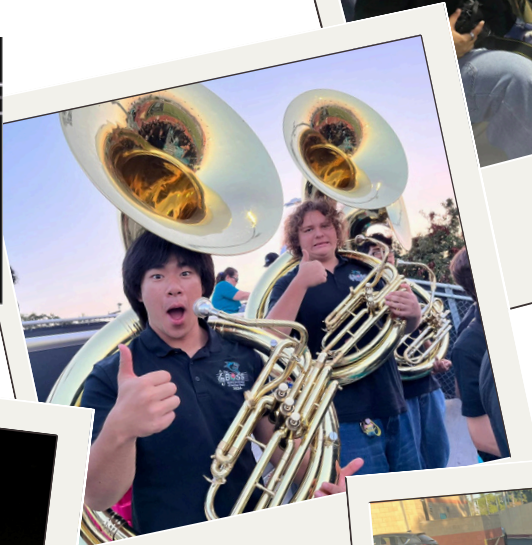

# FUNDRAISING

Thank you to everyone who brought in bags for the Clothing Drive! It was a big success! **We collected over 800 bags!!!**

We will be kicking off our **Country Meat Sticks** fundraiser in September. Country Meat Sticks are flavored meat sticks that are great for a snack. These sticks are perfect to put in lunches, a protein snack before practice, and just a fun snack! There are 14 different flavors to choose from. I will be offering samples of the different flavors to the students before we start the preorder fundraiser. This fundraiser could be very successful if we all participate! My **goal for this fundraiser is \$6,000!** We will be doing this fundraiser in three different ways.

- Traditional fundraising- We will purchase a few cases to sell at our home games, concerts, Band Festival, and possibly during lunchtime at school. I will also purchase a few cases to sell after the preorder. I know everyone is going to love the sticks and want to buy more of them!
- Online fundraising- You can go online and order your Country Meat sticks. You pay online and they will send the order to your house. This is great after we have done our preorder sale and you find the ones you like you can go online and order a box of them to have at home or sell them at your work. - Preorder forms fundraising. We are **starting our preorder fundraiser on September 11th!** I am asking each student to **sell at least 24 sticks.** Each stick is \$2. There will be 14 flavors to choose from. The student will have an order form and need to get orders and payment when the order is placed. Please help your student sell the meat sticks by taking them to work, to neighbors, friends, and family! Encourage them to take them to sporting events in the area and sell them there. I know they will love them. **On September 25th all order forms and money is due.** Please make sure the student's name is on the order form and the envelope with the money. I will distribute the orders on October 2nd. For every 24 sticks a student sells they will get their name put in for a raffle drawing for some fun new BOSS merchandise!

All funds raised go to support The BOSS! This means fundraising **funds help the marching band, concert band, orchestra, and color guard!** So please encourage your student to participate!

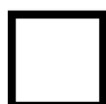
## UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Minimal makeup is to be worn.
- No jewelry is to be worn (or bandages need to be worn to cover jewelry).
- Must wear band-issued black crew neck t-shirt and black athletic shorts.
- Only wear **solid black mid-calf socks** (no logos or designs).
- Hair needs to be pulled back all the way up and secured with hair ties, head bands, hair pins, etc. on top of your head with NO wispy bangs or flyaways showing. If hair is longer than collar length, it needs to be secured up for proper shako wearing.
- **ONLY water** is to be consumed while wearing your uniform (unless consumables are provided and approved by the Band Boosters).
- Make sure you eat a good breakfast since you cannot eat or drink anything except water when you are preparing for and at the parade.
- Make sure you hang your uniform properly in the uniform bag and hang it on appropriate rack.
- Shako boxes should be kept on the same rack you found it on (they are kept in racks in alphabetical order).
- We must look “*uniform in uniform*” because we are scored in competition and points are deducted if we do not wear uniforms properly.
- We **MUST** take proper care of and make sure we keep our uniforms in clean and proper shape!

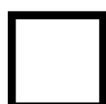
